The ships will be constructed at Fincantieri's Sestre Ponente facility in Genoa, Italy. The luxurious accommodations and dramatic public areas are designed by the world-renowned Norwegian architectural firm of Yran & Storbraaten.

Oceania Cruises and Fincantieri aim for new standards with the new Oceania Class - designed to elevate upper premium experiences to new heights. The new Oceania Class measures 782 feet long, 105 feet wide, with a draft of 24 feet, and will accommodate 1,260 guests on 11 guest decks. The ships will feature 630 staterooms and suites with sweeping ocean views and oversized, private verandas. The ships will be powered by diesel-electric engines and operate with twin screw propellers, with a speed of 20 knots. They will be equipped with two bow thrusters to enhance maneuverability.
